EC Leadership Conference

- Education committee leadership conference occurred; members of the PEC attended; CISVA planning on hosting networking opportunities for PECs in the new year

- Recommendations from the conference to include Catholic Identity mission and policy reviews

- Recommend reminding parents of the parent code of conduct annually – direct parents to the policy and what can find

Review of CISVA AGM

AGM was done via Zoom online; Fr. Paul and Deborah attended

COVID response was priority. CISVA looked at tuition response

Enrolment in CISVA down 3% - consistent with other schools and also due to decrease of international students

Edsembli Student Information System

New registration system for the school; Marnie Jangula is working with implementing this

System requires us to get our registration information out sooner – awaiting information from CISVA about potential tuition increase

Registration system will ensure the packages are completed by the parents before the registration can be submitted to the office – including the payment of outstanding fees

Catholic Identity and Mission

Discussion of how this might look in our meetings going forward – potentially asking staff to tell us how Christian life is being

Policy Review

Policy 110 (role of the PEC), 302 (major complaints), 321 (harassment), 306 (hiring practices) commended by the CISVA to review. PEC has recently reviewed these policies

Major Complaint Policy Update

If major complaint being made, the parent needs to provide a formal complaint to the CISVA's superintendent's office

Student Council

CCS Student council has been established – 10 students from the two grade 7 classes were selected based on applications.

Fr. Paul was invited to communicate with Clive about how this could be tied into Parish initiatives

Mandatory masks for staff outside their cohort

Principals have been given authority to mandate the wearing of masks by staff in schools. Mandate has been made that all staff out of their cohort in common areas shall wear masks

Air Purification systems for classrooms

Government COVID grant has been given and will be used to purchase surgical air purifiers for each classroom
