- We do anticipate TOC costs to be over budget to be able to accommodate the constraints brought on by COVID
- Open House will be ready to send out at the end of next week.
- A big thank you to Marnie who single handedly has been processing all of our registrations! Our new registrations are going to be made available online through MyEd BC.
- Our Artstarts presentation had be cancelled and has been postponed to May. The act we had planned for, The Bluesberries, have no more availability, so we have booked a First Nations storyteller.
- A big thank you to Ron Tamis, Matthew Klaponski and Hung Tran for their help with snow shoveling! This was a big job.
- We will be having a parent evening with Sr. John Mary Sullivan on January 27th for all parents in Grade 4-7 (virtually over Zoom). This is taking the place of the Sexuality and your Child evening that would have taken place this year. Last year we did a self-guided Love Ed program for parents.
- Basketball games for the first week back have been paused out of an abundance of caution. Practices are still going ahead. We are waiting for final word on safety of playing games. As of now, tournaments are suspended but single school games are still permitted.
